Students learn first-hand how easy filling out the fafsa form can be. In this activity, students go through the form step-by-step, answering questions on how to fill out certain sections, where to apply online, and where to go for help if they get stuck.

You just got your first paycheck, but wait...That number can't be right. In this activity, students practice how to read the components of their paystub, including the effect of taxes and deductions on net pay.


